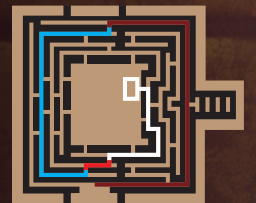
SOLUTION 01

Malvunali, with his good temperament, drew symbols in soft lines, while Zigorozti drew in harsh lines. Mentally piece together Malvunali's arrow and stand on the piece with the arrow's tip to open the way to the pyramid.



SOLUTION 03

Travelling counter-clockwise from the entrance, take the 2nd junction of the earth (brown) level, the 4th junction of the water (blue) level, the 1st junction of the the fire (red) level, and the 3rd junction of the air (white) level, to reach the symbol shown.



SOLUTION 05

The symbol you're looking for is on the side with the avocado. Assemble the pyramid starting from the top level. If you convert all goods to maize cobs, you'll see that the number of cobs will be the same on each level on one side.

Vanilla — 6 maize cobs, coffee —7, cacao—8, avocado - 9.

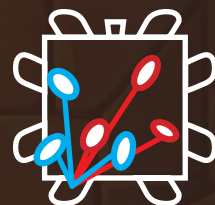


SOLUTION 07

Insert the amulet in the slot, first on one side, and then on the other. Move the amulet horizontally so that the symbols on the amulet and on the corresponding side of the other pyramid form new combinations. The symbol that appears twice (once on each side) is the one you need.





SOLUTION 10

Stand next to the portal with the axe. If you stand with your back to the portal, you will see Camaxtli, Cochimetl and Quetzal, but won't see Itzli, Xolotl and Tlaltecuctli. However, this condition can't be fulfilled if you stand in other portals.

**SOLUTION 12**

If you put the torch close to the top of the amulet (the dot), the light will come through a light guide and point to the right symbol. Put the torch to the same symbol on the pyramid on the wall to move forward.

SOLUTION 13

The stairs face east. The clouds are moved by the winds at the distance of 1 land. Only the following winds blew: 1) the north wind (moved only the biggest rain cloud to the south ); 2) the north-west wind (moved both rain clouds to the south-east ); 3) the east wind (brought all clouds, except the big rain cloud, to the west ); 4) the south wind (brought the smallest cloud to the north ).

SOLUTION 16

Find the statues of the three gods mentioned on the envelope pages in front of you. Take the beads and measure the distance from their statues — the god whose statue stands at an equal distance from these three gods is the one you are looking for Ehecatl.
