### SOLUTION 1

38. The only book that fully fits the description is the purple book on the top shelf with number 38 on its spine.

31. The date is written in big gray numbers on the background.

### SOLUTION 4

15. The phone number is a sequence of numbers: 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15. Every number differs by 2 from the previous one.

18. Add up eight (butter) and one (egg) and then double the result.

### SOLUTION 10

13. The left mouse has eaten one waffle square, and the right one — three squares.

### SOLUTION 12

32. Each number in the rhyme is twice as large as the previous one. The last number mentioned is 16, so the next number is 32.

28. Only the latch with a rotating handle (2) and the right wooden bar (8) block the door. The rest of the locks are either open or do not block the door.
